

# Hematology & Oncology Tip Sheet for ICD-10

## Diagnosis                      Documentation Requirements

<b>Anemia in Chronic Disease</b>	<b>Document the chronic disease and link it to the anemic:</b> - Anemic due to chronic kidney disease - Anemic due to colon cancer		
<b>Blood Loss Anemia</b>	<b>Document, when appropriate:</b> - Anemia due to acute blood loss - Anemia due to chronic blood loss	<b>If acute blood loss anemia is due to blood loss during surgery:</b> - Documentation of postoperative anemia is not enough - Document instead postoperative anemia <i>due to acute blood loss</i>	<b>When it is your clinical judgment that the surgery resulted in a expected amount of blood loss, no diagnosis of acute blood loss is needed</b>
<b>Nutritional Anemia</b>	<b>Document Iron deficiency anemia by type:</b> - Sideropenic iron deficiency anemia - Iron deficiency due to inadequate dietary iron intake	<b>Document vitamin B12 type, such as:</b> - Due to intrinsic factor deficiency - Vitamin B12 malabsorption	<b>Document folate deficiency type, such as:</b> - Due to diet - Drug induced  <b>Document other nutritional types, such as:</b> -Protein deficiency
<b>Other Drug Induced Blood Disorders</b>	<b>Document cause and effect, for example:</b> -Agranulocytosis due to sulfasalazine -Pancytopenia due to chemotherapy		
<b>Drug Underdosing</b>	<b>Document type:</b> - Intentional <i>versus</i> - Unintentional	<b>Document reason for underdosing, such as:</b> - Financial hardship <i>or</i> - Age related dementia	
<b>Leukemia</b>	<b>Document:</b> - Acute <i>versus</i> - Chronic	<b>Document specific type, for example:</b> - Acute lymphoblastic - Chronic lymphocytic of B-cell type - Prolymphocytic of B-cell type - Hairy cell - Adult T-cell	<b>Document remission-relapse status for each patient visit:</b> - Not having achieved remission - In remission - In relapse
<b>Neoplasms</b>	<b>Document specific site</b>  <b>Document laterality:</b> - Right - Left - Bilateral	<b>Detail</b> when a patient has presented for a specific treatment related to the neoplasm (e.g., surgical removal, chemotherapy, immunotherapy, radiation therapy)	<b>Document morphology:</b> - Malignant - Benign - In situ - Uncertain behavior - Unspecified behavior
<b>Obesity</b>	<b>Document etiology:</b> - Due to excess calories or nutritional - Due to drugs - Other, for example, due to thyroid or pituitary disorder	<b>If morbidly obese, also document if with alveolar hypoventilation</b>	<b>Document BMI</b>
<b>Tobacco Use Disorder</b>	<b>Document type:</b> - Cigarettes - Chewing tobacco - Other  <b>Delineate between:</b> - Tobacco use/abuse - Tobacco dependence	<b>Document state of dependence:</b> - In remission - With withdrawal - Without withdrawal	<b>Document</b> if used during pregnancy, childbirth, puerperium  <b>Describe</b> history, including product and time
